

Pennsylvania American Water Announces Water Line Upgrade Project in Washington Township

Pennsylvania American Water today announced the start of water line upgrade project to replace more than 1,500 feet of water main in Washington Township to improve reliability for customers and reduce service disruptions.

The project, which began last week, involves company contractors installing new 8-inch ductile iron pipe, replacing aged water main along Ackermanville Road.

Crews will begin work **7/27/2026**, working weekdays between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. Traffic restrictions will be in place during construction. The company expects to complete the water main installation, including connecting all customer service lines to the new mains, by the end of August with final restoration and paving to be completed by the end of the year.

During construction, customers might experience temporary service interruptions, discolored water, and/or lower than normal water pressure.
