

ORDINANCE NO. 137

AN ORDINANCE LAYING OUT, ESTABLISHING AND OPENING STILES AVENUE FROM THE WESTERN SIDE OF PENNSYLVANIA HIGHWAY ROUTE 191 WESTWARDLY A DISTANCE OF 884 FEET, AND VETERANS STREET FROM THE SOUTHERN SIDE OF STILES AVENUE SOUTHWARDLY A DISTANCE OF 250 FEET, IN WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

The Supervisors of the Township of Washington, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, in regular meeting assembled, being duly authorized to do so and having in all ways complied with the provisions of Section 1101 et seq. of The Second Class Township Code, as amended, do hereby enact and ordain that there are laid out and opened as streets within said Township, the following:

(a) STILES AVENUE - Beginning at a point of intersection of the center line of Stiles Avenue with the western side of Pennsylvania Highway Route 191, designated as Station 03 + 90, thence along said center line North 87 degrees West 884 feet to a point in line of lands now or late of Roscoe Stiles and being of a uniform width of 33 feet throughout its entire length as aforestated.

(b) VETERANS STREET - Beginning at a point of intersection of the southern side of Stiles Avenue with the center line of Veterans Street, said point being 344.5 feet West of the western side of Pennsylvania Highway Route 191 as measured along Stiles Avenue, thence along the center line of Veterans Street South 12 degrees 40 minutes West 250 feet to a point, and being of a uniform width of 33 feet throughout its entire length as aforestated.

The location and width of said streets, together with other relevant information concerning the improvements along the line thereof, as required by the Second Class Township Code, as amended, is set forth upon maps or surveys made by David O. Pritchard, Township Engineer, entitled "Map of North Section

of Veterans Street, Meyers Crossing" and "Map showing Stiles Avenue, Meyers Crossing" dated June 1962 and filed with the Secretary of the Board of Supervisors.
