

ORDINANCE NO. 138

AN ORDINANCE LAYING OUT AND OPENING PLUSH STREET, SLEEPY HOLLOW LANE, SCHOOL STREET, AND MIDWAY TERRACE IN THE WASHINGTON HEIGHTS DEVELOPMENT WITHIN WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND FIXING THE WIDTHS THEREOF.

The Supervisors of Washington Township, in Northampton County, Pennsylvania, in regular meeting assembled, being duly authorized so to do and having in all ways complied with the provisions of Section 1101 et seq. of The Second Class Township Code, as amended, do hereby enact and ordain that there are laid out and opened as public roads or streets within said Township, Plush Street, Sleepy Hollow Lane, School Street, and Midway Terrace, the center lines of said roads or streets being more particularly described as follows:

PLUSH STREET - Beginning at a point in the middle of the concrete pavement of State Highway Route 191, which leads from Ackermanville to Bangor; thence along the center line of Plush Street North 12 degrees 42 minutes West 330 feet to Station 3+30, which Station is at the center line of Sleepy Hollow Lane; thence continuing along the center of Plush Street North 12 degrees 42 minutes West 387 feet to a point, the end of Plush Street; being of a uniform width of 33 feet throughout its entire length, aforesaid.

SLEEPY HOLLOW LANE - Beginning at Station 3+30, on the center line of Plush Street, which point is 0+00 on the center line of Sleepy Hollow

Lane; thence along the center line of Sleepy Hollow Lane North 77 degrees 18 minutes East 166.5 feet to Station 1+66.5; thence North 54 degrees East 60.5 feet to Station 2+27; thence North 42 degrees East 80 feet to Station 3+07; thence North 36 degrees East 68 feet to Station 3+75, which Station is at the center line of Midway Terrace; thence North 4 degrees 46 minutes West 568 feet to Station 9+43, which Station is at the center line of School Street; being of a uniform width of 33 feet throughout its entire length, aforesaid.

SCHOOL STREET - Beginning at Station 9+43, which Station is at the center line of School Street; thence along the center line of School Street North 85 degrees 14 minutes East 335 feet to the middle of the concrete pavement of State Highway Route 191; being of a uniform width of 33 feet throughout its entire length, aforesaid.

MIDWAY TERRACE - Beginning at Station 3+75, which Station is on the center line of Sleepy Hollow Lane; thence along the center line of Midway Terrace North 85 degrees 14 minutes East 318 feet to the middle of the concrete pavement of State Highway Route 191; being of a uniform width of 33 feet throughout its entire length, aforesaid.

The location and width of said roads, together with relevant information concerning the improvements along the lines thereof, the names of the owners of property whereon said roads shall abut, as required by The Second Class Township Code, as

amended, are set forth upon a map or plan made by Michael A. Policelli, Registered Engineer, entitled "Map of property situated in Washington Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, "Washington Heights." Dated October, 1962.
