

WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP

ORDINANCE NO. 156

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, RESTRICTING AND REGULATING THE USE OF CERTAIN TOWNSHIP ROADS BY EXCLUDING THEREFROM THE USE OF TRUCKS, TRACTORS AND COMMERCIAL VEHICLES, EXCEPT FOR LOCAL PURPOSES, AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF SIGNS INDICATING SUCH RESTRICTION AND REGULATION.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of Washington Township through its supervisors under the Act of Assembly of April 29, 1959, P. L. 58 as amended, 75 P. S. 1101 as follows:

SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to drive or operate any truck, trailer, semitrailer or other commercial motor vehicle over or upon the following roads in the said township:

Township Rt. #625 from Legislature Rt. #48091 to Legislature Rt. #48165 *Johnson Rd*

Township Rt. #682 from Legislature Rt. #48165 to Township Rt. #680 *Ackermanville Rd*

Township Rt. #669 from Legislature Rt. #48091 to Legislature Rt. #48036

Township Rt. #667 from Legislature Rt. #48091 to Legislature Rt. #48165 *West Factoryville Rd.*

Township Rt. #698 from Legislature Rt. #48013 to Legislature Rt. #48032

Township Rt. #679 *Park Rd.* from Bangor Borough Line off of Legislature Rt. #48033 to Legislature Rt. #48074

Township Rt. #706 from Legislature Rt. #48033 to East Bangor Borough Line *Lock Hgts Rd.*

Township Rt. #677 from Legislature Rt. #48165 to Legislature
Rt. #48033 *Springfield Dr.*

Township Rt. #678 from Township Rt. #663 to Township Rt. #677
W. Pleasant Rd

SECTION 2: The Supervisors of Washington Township shall erect, or cause to be erected and maintained, official signs authorized by the Secretary of Highways of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania at the entrance to all the township roads referred to in Section 1 and the intersections thereof for the purpose of directing and warning of the prohibited use of said township roads by certain classes of motor vehicles as stated herein.

SECTION 3: The provisions of this Ordinance shall not apply to buses or commercial motor vehicles transporting and discharging passengers locally within the limits of Washington Township, to vehicles of any Fire Department, or to vehicles of any public utility work, or to vehicles making local deliveries to persons or firms situated along said township roads or to vehicles owned by a political subdivision, private firm or person using said township roads to provide local services.

SECTION 4: Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon summary conviction before any Justice of the Peace, be sentenced to pay a fine for each and every offense of not more than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution, or, upon default of payment of the fine and costs, shall be sentenced and com-

mitted to the county jail for a period of not more than five (5) days.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days from the date hereof.
