ORDINANCE NO. 205

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 176, AND AUTHORIZING THE TAX COLLECTOR OF WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP TO IMPOSE A FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF REAL ESTATE TAX CERTIFICATIONS AND RETAIN THE FEE FOR THE COLLECTION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Township of Washington has heretofore enacted Ordinance No. 176 authorizing the Tax Collector of Washington Township to impose a fee for the issuance of real estate tax certifications and retain the fee for the collection of same; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Washington wishes to amend said Ordinance to comply with the provisions of Section 3(a) of the Pennsylvania State Ethics Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, as follows:

(1) Washington Township hereby appoints its locally elected Tax Collector as a municipal officer authorized to provide tax certifications upon request by the general public.

(2) The Township of Washington hereby authorizes the said Tax Collector to assess, collect and retain as compensation for providing such additional services, a fee of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per certification.

(3) The authorization set forth in this Ordinance shall extend to elected Tax Collectors, appointed Tax Collectors, and other individuals lawfully serving on an interim basis as a Tax Collector for the Township of Washington.

(4) The fee for providing the Tax Certification to the general public by the Tax Collector may be amended from time to time at the discretion of the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, by Resolution.

(5) All other Ordinances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this Ordinance, are hereby repealed.

(6) This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment.
