ORDINANCE NO. 222

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON ESTABLISHING A LAWFUL SPEED LIMIT ON EAST FACTORYVILLE ROAD, (TR 604), BETWEEN ACKERMANVILLE ROAD (TR 680), AND SOUTH MAIN STREET, AT THIRTY-FIVE (35) MILES PER HOUR.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined, through the Township Engineer, that it is in the best interests of the Township to establish the following speed limit on East Factoryville Road (TR 604), between Ackermanville Road (TR 680), and South Main Street, within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the said Township Engineer has conducted a study to clearly define an appropriate speed limit for said roadway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that East Factoryville Road (TR 604), between Ackermanville Road (TR 680), and South Main Street, shall be properly marked with speed limit signs of thirty-five (35) miles per hour.

All other Ordinances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this Ordinance, are hereby repealed.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment.
