ORDINANCE NO. 243

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 173, ALSO KNOWN AS THE WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP MOVING PERMIT ORDINANCE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same:

- Section 1: Ordinance No. 173 enacted April 11, 1990, is hereby amended in part to provide the following:
- 1. Section 5 of Ordinance No. 173 is amended to provide a payment of a fee of Five and no/100 (\$5.00) Dollars payable to the Township of Washington. All other provisions of Section 5 of Ordinance No. 173 shall remain in full force and effect.
- 2. Section 7 of Ordinance No. 173 is amended to provide a fine not exceeding One Thousand and no/100 (\$1,000.00) Dollars, plus costs. All other provisions of Section 7 of Ordinance No. 173 shall remain in full force and effect.
- 3. All other provisions of Ordinance No. 173 shall remain in full force and effect.
- 4. If any part of this Ordinance is found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, said unconstitutional or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions hereof.
- 5. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after its enactment.
