ORDINANCE NO. 270

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS ON BENNS HILL ROAD AND MACK ROAD WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP, AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, through its duly appointed engineer, Ott Consulting Inc., has conducted a traffic study of Benns Hill Road and Mack Road to determine a speed limit for said roads; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors wishes to use the results of the aforementioned study to establish speed limits on Benns Hill Road and Mack Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 1:

The speed limit for Benns Hill Road shall be established and posted at 35 Miles Per Hour for its entire length.

Section 2:

The speed limit for Mack Road shall be established and posted at 30 Miles Per Hour for its entire length.

Section 3:

Any ordinance, or part thereof, inconsistent with this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

Section 4:

This Ordinance shall be placed into effect immediately upon enactment.

Section 5:

Any violations of this Ordinance shall be governed by the provisions of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code for regulations of speed on public roadways.
