ORDINANCE NO. 292

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING THE SPEED LIMIT ON FRONT STREET WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP, AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, through its duly appointed engineer, Ott Consulting Inc., has conducted a traffic study of Front Street to determine the speed limit for said road; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors wishes to use the results of the aforementioned study to establish the speed limit on Front Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 1:

The speed limit for Front Street from the Roseto Borough municipality boundary line to Bangor Junction Road shall be established and posted at 25 Miles Per Hour for its entire length.

Section 2:

Any ordinance, or part thereof, inconsistent with this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

Section 3:

This Ordinance shall be placed into effect immediately upon enactment.

Section 4:

Any violations of this Ordinance shall be governed by the provisions of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code for regulations of speed on public roadways.
